### **Changes at SABIC and what they mean for your pension**

In January of this year, SABIC announced its intention to sell its Dutch activities to two German investors: Innovative Plastics BV will be acquired by Mutares, while Limburg BV and Europe BV will transfer to AEQUITA. Both acquiring companies are private-equity firms based in Munich.

### The Accountability Council keeps a critical eye

The Accountability Council (AC) plays an important role within SPF. The Management Board is accountable to the AC. Thereby, the AC focuses primarily on what the Management Board does. It assesses the content of decisions, and weighs whether these decisions are in the best interest of all members. The AC's annual assessment is also included in SPF's annual report. In addition, the AC can advise the Board on specific topics. In this way, the AC contributes to careful and balanced policy.

A key topic this year was the decision on integration of accrued rights. This decision concerns the transition to the new pension system and how the fund's assets will be allocated at that moment. The Board reached its decision in January 2026, after which the AC assessed it and issued advice.
